Fixed ratio (FR)	Reinforcement depends on a definite number of responses	Activity slows after rein- forcement and then picks up
Var(able ratio (VR)	Number of responses psected for reinforcement varies	Orestest activity of all schedules results
Fixed interval (FI)	Reinforcement depends on a fixed time	Activity increases as decline nears
Variable interval (VI) Time between reinforcement varies	Sinady activity results
